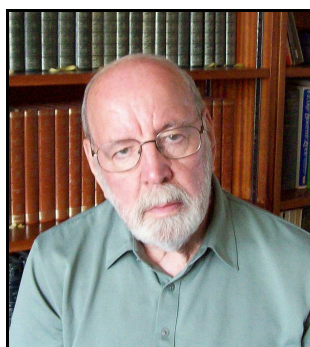


A children's
